
# ORIGINS OF SOCIOLOGICAL THINKING



## SOCIOLOGICAL THINKING

 The first systematic analysis of society is found in the philosophies of <u>early Greek philosophers</u> such as <u>Plato</u> and <u>Aristotle</u>. These approaches did not reflect a modern sociological perspective because their work emphasized how society <u>ought to be</u>, rather than describing <u>how</u> <u>society actually was</u>.



# THE AGE OF ENLIGHTENMENT

Subsequent contributions to sociology would come later and proposed the idea of <u>universal laws</u> and <u>self-regulating systems</u>; and from the Age of Enlightenment whose contributions were on two fronts. First, it emphasized the importance of <u>critical reasoning</u> and <u>experience to the individual</u>; second, the Enlightenment itself produced an <u>intellectual revolution</u> in how people thought about <u>social change</u>, and <u>progress</u>. This change of 'mind' would lay the foundation for the '<u>revolutions</u>' (social and industrial) of the eighteenth, nineteenth and early twentieth centuries.



#### INDUSTRIALIZATION

• This refers to the process by which societies are transformed from dependence on <u>agriculture</u> and <u>handmade products</u> to an emphasis on <u>manufacturing</u> and related industries - and <u>urbanization</u> -the process by which an increasing proportion of a population lives in <u>cities</u> rather than <u>rural areas</u>—contributed to the development of sociological thinking.
